



## 12. BIOGRAPHY (ADVANCED)

**TYPE OF ACTIVITY:** Matching

**STANDARDS:** 1.2 Interpreting, 1.3 Presenting, 3.2 Other Perspectives, 4.1 Interdisciplinary Connections, 5.2 Life-long Learning

**OBJECTIVES:** To learn about famous people or characters in the language community.

To discover research materials for topics in their language. To build library skills.

### STUDENT PREPARATION

Students will research the life of a famous person or character using several different sources. They will need to use at least three sources in the target language. They should write the report in the first person.

### TEACHER PREPARATION

The Teacher prepares a worksheet with the names of all the characters presented and the names of all students in the class and saves it as a digital document in the lessons folder.

## IN THE LAB

### RECORD BUTTON

Students will **RECORD** their report but they should not include the name of the Person or character they researched in their recording.

### COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the **COLLECT RECORDINGS** feature (**SOLOIST Remote Control**) to close students' audio files and collects them in one file folder.

### LAUNCH FILE

Teacher opens (**GROUP CONTROL**) the worksheet for all students.

### OPEN FILE

Teacher will open and play (**SOLOIST REMOTE CONTROL**) select audio files to all students and ask them to match the character to the student who researched him or her.
