



## 15. SUMMARIES (ADVANCED)

**TYPE OF ACTIVITY:** Individual Practice/Class Assessment

**STANDARDS:** 1.3 Presenting, 3.1 Interdisciplinary Connections

**OBJECTIVES:**

- To evaluate understanding of familiar text or dialogue
- To express coherent thoughts in the target language
- To vary practice of textbook material
- To focus on main idea and supporting details

## TEACHER PREPARATION

Teacher selects a dialogue, article or story line from previously practiced material. In class, teachers have students review selected written material.

## IN THE LAB

### RECORD (Student SOLOIST)

After practicing or reviewing the selected material, students record a summary of the action or content from the written material.

### COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher collects student recordings ([SOLOIST Remote Control](#)) for grading or mastery evaluation.

### FOLLOW-UP

Teacher asks for volunteers to have their summaries played for the class. Class discusses elements of good summaries. (In the lab or in the classroom)
