



16. WHO PREFERS ICE CREAM TO SORBET? (BEGINNER)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Opinion – Individual Response Comparisons

STANDARDS: 1.1 Conversing, 5.1 Language Communities

OBJECTIVES: Review of vocabulary linked to foods, activities or sports

TEACHER PREPARATION

The teacher prepares a list of ten questions using the verb to prefer.

Ex: Do you prefer ice cream or sorbet?

IN THE LAB

ALL CALL

Teacher reads the questions to the class and asks the students respond verbally.

RECORD/DRILL

The teacher records their answers using the [RECORD/DRILL](#) button.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the collect recording feature ([SOLOIST Remote Control](#)) to close students' audio files and collect them in one file folder.

OPEN FILE

The teacher sends select audio files to the entire class.



Students listen to several the recordings. They then type ([TEXT EDITOR Student SOLOIST](#)) a class summary of food preferences based on the information heard in their classmate's recordings.

Ex: Three students like ice cream and fifteen students do not like it.

COLLECT WORK

The teacher collects ([SOLOIST Remote Control](#)) the written text summaries and saves them in one file folder.
