



22. WHAT TIME IS IT? (BEGINNER)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Listening/Note-Taking

STANDARDS: 1.1 Conversing, 5.1 Language Communities

OBJECTIVES: To review numbers from 1-60; To practice expressions for telling time.

TEACHER PREPARATION

Teacher records twenty different times of the day (It is one thirty, two fifty five.) saving the recording in the lesson folder. Teacher will also type the twenty different answers and save in the lesson folder.

IN THE LAB

Teacher gives students a sheet with twenty different clocks.

The face of each clock is blank.

OPEN FILE

Teacher uses this function to [SEND](#) and [PLAY](#) the audio file for all students.

PLAYBACK

Students can listen to the recording several times on their own and draw the hands on the clocks. Students then give their sheet to another student.

LAUNCH FILE (PC Control)

Teacher uses this function to send the answers document to all students' desktops.

Students will correct and grade their classmates' work.
