



23. YOUR BIRTHDAY = YOUR FUTURE (INTERMEDIATE)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Listening/Note-Taking

STANDARDS: 1.2 Interpreting, 3.1 Interdisciplinary Connections 5.1 Language Communities

OBJECTIVES: Review of the future tense and of expressions relating to geography, travel activities, and the verbs to meet and work.

STUDENT PREPARATION

Students write a complete horoscope including the twelve signs of the zodiac. For each sign they should include the following:

Work: You will find a new summer job in a restaurant

Travel: You will visit (name of country this summer) and you will learn to (name of activity)

Social life: You will meet a new friend (description) in (place/while doing a certain activity).

IN THE LAB

RECORD (Student SOLOIST)

Students will record their horoscope on their computer and place it in a folder.

Students will then visit two other computers and listen to the recordings of their classmates. They will take notes on the predictions for their own sign.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the [COLLECT RECORDING](#) feature to close students' audio files and collect them in one audio folder.

FOLLOW-UP

Teacher uses the [CONFERENCE](#) function so that students can compare what they learned about their future with their classmates.
