



26. COULD YOU REPEAT THAT, PLEASE? (INTERMEDIATE)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Sentence Completion/Deductions

STANDARDS: 1.1 Conversing, 1.2 Interpreting, 4.1 Inter-Linguistic Comparisons, 5.1 Language Communities

OBJECTIVES:

- To review coordinating conjunctions
- To review the past tense
- To practice reporting speech

TEACHER PREPARATION

The Teacher prepares an audio file. The audio file could be a recording of a phone message left by a friend explaining what he/she will do this weekend. Unfortunately, parts of several sentences are missing. The conversation should take place in a setting related to a unit studied in class. Save the audio file in the lessons folder.

STUDENT PREPARATION

Students will need to review the verbs used to report a story in their different forms.

IN THE LAB

OPEN FILE

The teacher will [SEND](#) the audio file to all students. Students listen to the recording and prepare a phone message for another friend. In that message they will report on the plans they just heard about ask their friend to join them. Students must complete the missing parts of the first recording in order to prepare their message.

RECORD BUTTON

Students press the [RECORD](#) button and record their message.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the [COLLECT RECORDING](#) feature to close students' audio files and collect them in one file folder.

FOLLOW-UP



Teacher will use the [OPEN FILE](#) function to play a selected recording to all students. He/she will use the [CONFERENCE](#) function so that students can compare the different message with their classmates. Repeat with another student's recording as time allows.
