



## 31. HEAD, SHOULDERS, KNEES AND TOES (BEGINNER)

**TYPE OF ACTIVITY:** Blind Directions

**STANDARDS:** 1.3 Presenting, 2.1 Customs, 4.2 Intercultural Comparisons, 5.2 Life-long Learning

**INSTRUCTIONAL OBJECTIVES:**

To review vocabulary related to body parts

## STUDENT PREPARATION

Students prepare a drawing of an extra-terrestrial.

## IN THE LAB

Each student is given a picture of an extraterrestrial with several heads, arms, legs...etc. Students do not receive their own drawing. They have a few minutes to observe the picture and prepare a description.

## PAIR

Teacher assigns students to **PAIRS** using the **PAIR White Board function**. Students draw (using whiteboard feature) the extraterrestrial their partner received based only on their partner's verbal description.

Students can only ask yes/no questions and they have five minutes each to complete this activity. The teacher changes pairs after ten minutes.

When students complete drawing two or three extraterrestrials the teacher will end the activity.



## OPTION

### COLLECT WORK

The teacher will [COLLECT \(SOLOIST Remote Control\)](#) all the whiteboard drawings.

Teacher asks students to present the drawings they made during the activity. The student's partner can then present the original and compare it to their classmate's drawings.
