



32. CAN YOU TELL ME HOW TO GET TO....? (INTERMEDIATE)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Blind Directions

STANDARDS: 1.2 Interpreting, 1.3 Presenting, 5.1 Language Communities

INSTRUCTIONAL OBJECTIVES:

- To review vocabulary used to give directions
- To review the verb “to go”

TEACHER PREPARATION

Teacher will scan a map of a city or neighborhood and save it in the lessons and folder.

IN THE LAB

OPEN FILE

The teacher sends ([OPEN FILE](#)) the file to all students and will ask them to pick one destination identified by a star on the map. Students all start from the same place, designated by the teacher ex. Madrid on a map of Spain).

RECORD BUTTON

Students will state their name and [RECORD](#) directions to go from their starting point to their destination.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the [COLLECT RECORDING](#) feature to close students' audio files and collect them in file folder.



OPEN FILE

Teacher will send [\(OPEN FILE\)](#) a volunteer's audio file to all the students.

Students listen to the file and identify their classmate's destination.

CONFERENCE

Using the [CONFERENCE](#) function the teacher will ask a student to identify their classmate's destination.

Repeat as time allows opening another audio file for the class and repeating the above [OPEN FILE](#) and [CONFERENCE](#) directions.
