



43. CELEBRITY PROFILES (BEGINNER)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Storytelling

STANDARDS: 1.3 Presenting, 2.1 Customs, 5.1 Language Communities

INSTRUCTIONAL OBJECTIVES:

- To review vocabulary used to describe hobbies
- To learn to use the third person to talk about someone else
- To review cultural facts about daily life.

STUDENT PREPARATION

Students will prepare a short interview (one minute) based on the show lifestyle of the rich and famous. They will choose a character from the culture of the language they study. Students will be prepared to record an interview of the character in his/her home.

IN THE LAB

RECORD BUTTON

Students will **RECORD** their interview of one of the character without mentioning his or her name.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the **COLLECT RECORDING/WORK** feature to close students' audio files and collect them in one audio folder. Teacher will grade recordings for accuracy.

OPEN FILE

The teacher will open (**OPEN FILE**) a volunteer's audio file. Students will take notes using the **TEXT EDITOR (in SOLOIST)** on the following items: hobbies, projects, likes/dislikes and/or accomplishments of the characters being interviewed.



CONFERENCE

Teacher uses the [CONFERENCE](#) function to allow students to guess the name of the character presented.

Repeat with additional volunteer recordings as time allows.
