



50. POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS (BEGINNER)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Oral Evaluation of Grammar

STANDARDS: 1.1 Conversing, 4.1 Inter-linguistic Comparisons, 5.1 Language Communities

INSTRUCTIONAL OBJECTIVES:

To review of the use of possessive pronouns in sentences

TEACHER PREPARATION

Teacher prepares a worksheet with a set of fifteen drawings and thirty names for classroom use. Teacher then prepares an answer sheet showing each object matched to one or two names. This answer sheet is saved as a word document in the lessons folder.

STUDENT PREPARATION

Students will practice make sentences using a name and an object in the classroom from the worksheet.

IN THE LAB

ALL CALL

Using the **ALL CALL** function, the teacher will ask students to match each object to the correct name(s). He/she will use sentences such as: "The book is Julie's."

CONFERENCE

Using the **CONFERENCE** function, all of the students may respond.



LAUNCH FILE (PC Control)

The teacher uses [LAUNCH FILE \(in PC Control\)](#) to open the answer document on every student's desktop. Students can then check their own worksheet.

ALL CALL

Teacher uses the [ALL CALL](#) function to communicate with all of the students and ask them to record a sentence using a possessive adjective about each pair object/name(s).

RECORD

Each student [RECORDS](#) his/her sentences in a new file.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Teacher uses the [COLLECT RECORDING/WORK](#) feature to close students' audio files and collect them in one file folder for grading.
