



7. QUESTIONS/ANSWER OR ANSWER/QUESTION (BEGINNER)

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: Stimulus/Response

STANDARDS: 1.1 Conversing, 3.1 Interdisciplinary Connections, 4.1 Inter-linguistic Comparisons

OBJECTIVES: To review question structures

STUDENT PREPARATION

At home students complete two homework assignments. In the first assignment they give a YES/NO answer to a given question. In the second assignment they write the questions when given a YES/NO answer.

IN THE LAB

ALL CALL

Using the [ALL CALL](#) function, the teacher will read the questions from the homework assignment to the students and ask them to give the answers orally. The teacher may choose whether to allow students to look at their homework. The teacher reads a new set of questions (students will not have seen these questions) and students will speak their answers. The teacher completes the same task with the answers to question activity.

RECORD/DRILL

The teacher will use the group [RECORD/DRILL](#) function to record the student responses after each question.

COLLECT RECORDINGS

Using the [COLLECT RECORDING/WORK](#) function, the teacher will collect all of the student recordings in one folder for grading.
